## **Innovation Impact**

Economists have shown a strong linkage between a nation's or region's prosperity and its capacity to innovate. Universities and specifically engineering colleges impact that capacity through the development of talent at all degree levels and through high impact ideas flowing from industry-university collaborative research programs. In 2006, the leadership of the College of Engineering at Oregon State University created a single output metric that measures our progress in building a capacity for innovation, while expressing our relative values in the components we deliver. This composite metric also has the following attributes:

- derived from reliable data that is routinely collected
- updated annually allowing progress to be monitored
- easily understood by our various constituencies
- more directly measures our impact on the regional economy than existing metrics.

The Innovation Impact ( $I^2$ ) metric is computed for a given year from four output measures and associated weights linked to the College's values in our core mission;

- Baccalaureate degrees weighted 40,
- Masters degrees weighted 10,
- Doctoral degrees weighted 20, and
- Research Expenditures weighted 30.

These data are gathered from the American Society for Engineering Education (ASEE) annual reports. The reported data must be normalized to allow combination into the Innovation Impact metric. Considering that the U.S. News and World Report Top 25 Graduate Schools of Engineering are broadly accepted as best at delivering talent and breakthrough ideas, we normalize each component using the average output from that group. The Innovation Impact metric is then calculated as follows:

$$\text{Innovation Impact Metric} = 40 \times (\text{BS Degrees}/\text{BS Norm}) + 10 \times (\text{MS Degrees}/\text{MS Norm}) + 20 \times (\text{PhD Degrees}/\text{PhD Norm}) + 30 \times (\text{Research Expenditures}/\text{Research Expenditure Norm})$$

where norms in each category are average outputs of the US News and World Report Top 25 Graduate Schools of Engineering.

Innovation Impact metrics for all engineering programs included in the 2006 ASEE report are provided in the attached table.
